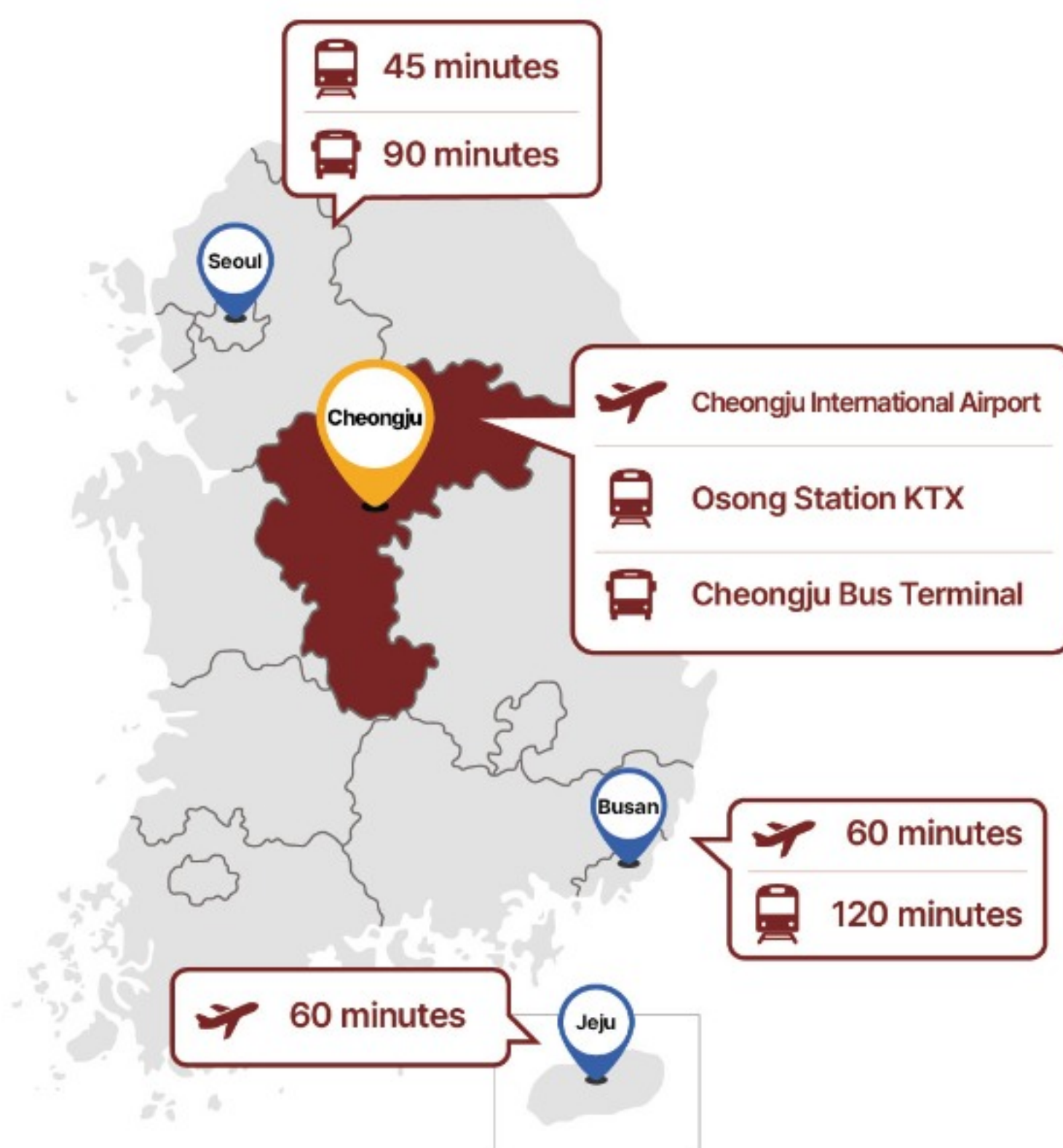

What is CBNU G-Cruit

- ▶ CBNU G-Cruit is both a scholarship program operated by Chungbuk National University (CBNU) to recruit outstanding new graduate students, and an online platform that connects prospective researchers around the world with CBNU professors and research labs.
- ▶ You can submit a Pre-Application online with ease. Your application information is forwarded by the Office of International Affairs (OIA) to the relevant department and prospective academic advisor (professor). Through this process, applicants can identify professors and labs that match their research interests in advance and gain an opportunity to begin research quickly after enrollment.
- ▶ Once you submit the Pre-Application, scholarship screening, the graduate admissions process, and Academic Advisor matching are efficiently linked and carried out.



Program Highlights



Apply Easily Online

During the announced application period, you can submit your Pre-Application through the CBNU G-Cruit Platform. After completing the simple online Pre-Application procedure, you will proceed to the official graduate admissions application.



Approximately 50 Scholars Selected Each Semester

The CBNU G-Cruit Scholarship Program selects around 50 newly admitted graduate students each semester. The number of awardees may vary depending on the semester's plan and budget.



Participation of Over 100 CBNU Faculty Members

With more than 100 professors and diverse research labs participating at CBNU, you can choose from a wide range of disciplines and research topics, including the humanities, sciences, engineering, agriculture, medicine, and more.



Open to Master's, Ph.D., and Integrated Master's/Ph.D. Programs

Applicants may apply to the program that best fits their academic plans: Master's, Ph.D., or the Integrated Master's/Ph.D. Program.

CBNU G-Cruit Benefits

▶ Full Tuition Support

- Full tuition waiver (Grade A)
- Master's/Ph.D. programs: up to 4 semesters
- Integrated Master's/Ph.D. Program: up to 8 semesters
- Focus on your studies and research without the burden of tuition fees.
- Personal expenses such as airfare and living costs are not covered.

▶ Advisor & Lab Confirmed Before Enrollment

Reduce the adjustment period after arrival and begin research faster.

- Confirm your Academic Advisor(Prof.) and research lab before enrollment.
- Coordinate your research plan in advance.
- Start research immediately after enrollment in a well-prepared environment.

▶ Additional Funding Opportunities (By Lab)

- Some labs may provide additional funding.
- Availability and amounts vary by professor/lab and should be discussed individually.

Check the scholarship information and how to apply, and confirm that you meet the eligibility requirements.

Explore the Faculty & Lab Board

Find professors and labs that match your research interests in advance.

Submit the Pre-Application

Complete your basic information and research plan, then submit your Pre-Application online.

5

Document Review & Online Interview Evaluation

OIA and faculty members evaluate your application based on the submitted information.

6

Scholarship Selection

If selected, you will receive guidance on the official graduate admissions procedure.
