- 3 Your home university will nominate successful candidates to KMOU.



Deadline for Nomination: April 22, 2026



Applicant's Qualifications

- 1 Nationality: Japanese ONLY
- 2 Currently enrolled in a regular undergraduate program at a Japanese university
- 3 Between 18 and under 30 years of age
- 4 Physically and mentally fit to study abroad in Korea
- 5 Sufficient English proficiency to complete the entire program: One of the following two options
 - TOEIC 650, IELTS 5.0, TOEFL iBT 65 or above
 - Confirmation of English Proficiency issued by the international office or a faculty member of the applicant's home university
